Established as a well-known healer, teacher-mentor and servant leader, Norma Jean has taught at Harvard, Planetree Hospitals, for the American Medical Students Association and was the principal healer testing the Efficacy of Reiki Treatment with Fibromyalgia – funded by the National Institute of Health. She advises a 5 year grant bringing Integral Methods to the UW School of Nursing curriculum and finds great enjoyment in mentoring medical students.

She was initiated as a master in 1985, after apprenticing 3 years with the grand-daughter of Madame Takata, who brought Reiki to the Western world from patriarchal Japan. Reiki became the avenue of working toward her life purpose, to do what she could to integrate the family of humankind, functionally, even though she had abandoned it as too large.

Through teaching-healing in 13 countries, she has served and learned from Original People, founding the Global Wisdom-Keeping Grandmothers Project. These include the Inuit of Greenland, the Wanapum of Washington, the lepers of Indonesia, and the Maori of New Zealand. She has also taught in Greece, Europe and Japan. 23 years of service.

Norma Jean loves people. She is vital, inspiring, fun and thought provoking – a gifted teacher and healer who lives to see the light brighten in her fellow humans' eyes.
